School-Wide Assessment and Internal Monitoring Schedule, Indicators and Targets

(Adapted from the Dalrymple Alliance Assessment Overview)

This document has been established by the Principals of the Band 5 / 6 Schools in the Dalrymple Alliance. A range of research based, commercially available, quality assessment tools for primary English, Mathematics, Science, History and Geography have been selected. For each KLA a “C” or “Sound” standard across all year levels from Prep to Year 7 have been clearly identified as the Benchmarks for schools within the Dalrymple Alliance. These standards are reflective of the relevant Queensland Curriculum Assessment and Reporting Framework documents and are aligned with the relevant standards for each year level in the Australian Curriculum and are consistent with the norms of the relevant assessment tools. See Appendix 2 for agreed upon standards and assessment formats.

It is important to ensure there is a range and balance of assessment instruments and assessable elements across the KLAs and year levels. A worthwhile assessment program:

- Includes a range and balance of assessment instruments;
 - Ensures that assessments provide evidence of student learning of the assessable elements for the KLA within the reporting period;
 - Ensures that the coverage of assessable elements is balanced;
 - Allows for the collection of evidence of student learning over time; and
 - Is used to provide feedback to students, teachers and parents about learning.
- (QSA – Building Student Success)

Properly implemented and accurately interpreted, the identified diagnostic assessment instruments will enable Teachers, Principals and Alliance members to:

- Identify strengths and areas for development for individual students and cohorts;
- Measure distance travelled within specific timeframes;
- Compare achievement relative to “norms” and national benchmarks; and
- Personalise learning.

The “C” or “Sound” standard are end-of-year standards for each identified year level. The “Semester 1 Benchmarks” are used as tracking advice for Teachers and Principals to see how the cohort is progressing towards the end of year benchmark. Teachers and Principals are able to identify the number or percentage of the cohort who will reach the nominated benchmark by the end of Semester 1 and by the end of the year. Information on the cohort from the previous year can be entered in the “Current Data / Indicators” column. This will enable the Teachers and Principal to track the growth of that cohort from the end of the previous year through Semester 1 and to the end of the current year. See Appendix 1 for an example of a completed year level schedule.

The benchmarks established in this document **cannot** be changed by individual schools. Any changes to benchmarks need to be decided by the Principals of the Dalrymple Alliance as a collective. Schools need to record their student’s progress in the identified assessments against the benchmarks. Principals and teachers can choose how this is collated. It is recommended to use the Diagnostic / Standardised application as part of OneSchool. An Alliance data base is being developed where all schools will forward their PM, PROBE, PAT R, PAT M, Sight Words and South Australian Spelling data to a nominated Principal who will present this to the Alliance members for regular discussion.

NAPLAN Results are not spread across Semesters; rather this data is for that calendar year.

Appendix 2: Agreed upon assessment standards and testing formats.

- In **PM** the desired achievement of a level is - 95% reading accuracy, Satisfactory / Sound Comprehension and Retelling Indicators (Instructional Level)
- **Probe testing** will be conducted utilising method 1: – Student reads aloud, Teacher records reading behaviours, errors etc. Teacher asks comprehension questions and teacher writes student response. A reading age is determined when a result is achieved testing with option 1 (Decoding and Comprehension) – minimum 96% decoding and minimum 70% Comprehension.
- **Informal Prose Inventory** testing will be conducted as follows: - Student reads text aloud when prompted by the teacher. Teacher records reading behaviours, errors etc. A **pass** for this section is **97%**. A score of less than 94% indicates that this passage is too difficult and you need to go to a lower level. The student rereads the passage silently before attempting a **retell** including as many events and details as they can remember. Use Section A, side 2 of the recording sheet and tick boxes of events or details that have been retold. A pass for this section is **50%**. When the student completes the retell, tick the boxes in Section B that have already been covered satisfactorily in Section A. Use the questions provided to check **comprehension** of events and details not retold. As the inferential questions to test students ability to “read between the lines”. A **pass** for this section is **75%**. Students must pass all 3 sections of Accuracy, Retelling and Comprehension before moving to the next level.
- **ALL PAT testing** to be conducted in February and then again in November.
- As an Alliance we have decided it does not matter what sights words list you use, as long as the benchmarks are consistent.
